eLearning Course

Start mastering key academic info at your own pace. Compatible with mobile devices, the time commitment is 5-10 hours.



STEP 2: Get Wet
 POOL

Pool Training

Complete in-water skill training in a pool or confined water under instructor supervision. Time commitment: 4-8 hours over two weekends.



STEP 3: Go Diving
 OPEN WATER

Open Water Dives

Complete required open-water training dives with your instructor. Time commitment: 4-8 hours over two weekends.

When you start learning to scuba dive, as a minimum, you will need to own a *Mask, Snorkel, Fins, Boots*. At Ray Scuba, we personalize the fitting to make sure it's the right gear for you.

Tips ... The customary tip in the scuba diving industry often ranges from 10% to 20% of the total cost of the diving services. Keep in mind that tipping is a gesture of gratitude for a job well done, and it's always appreciated by the hardworking individuals who contribute to making your diving experience enjoyable and safe.

Other Costs to know about ... Rental Gear (BCD, Regulator, Computer, Tank, Weights) for Check Out Dives (\$30 per day) add \$25 for Premium Gear, Wetsuit Rental (\$20 per day), Dive Resort Entry Fee and parking (\$25-\$45 per day), Air Fills filled at destinations (\$12-\$20 per tank)

Prerequisites: Able to swim; medically fit for diving, Minimum age: 10 years or older

The Process:

1. Purchase your open water eLearning code by, stopping in, calling, or through our website.
2. Schedule your orientation which includes getting fitted for your personal gear and filling out the course forms including the medical questionnaire and waiver forms.
3. After completing your eLearning, please schedule ahead and call us to inform us of the pool day you would like to join. You can check the calendar on our website for availability. We will run pool sessions 1 and 2 the first half of our pool time and pool sessions 3, 4, 5 during the second half of our pool time. Typically, each pool session is an hour.
4. The morning of your first pool session you will have in person classroom at 9am to complete a quick review quiz, have an opportunity to discuss any questions with your instructor, and practice gear assembly. After a lunch break, we will meet you at the pool.
5. After you have completed a few pool sessions you can begin your checkout dives with us at one of our local quarries, discuss with your instructor which check out dives you can do. It's important to note, you must have pool session 1 and 2 completed before being able to do your open water check out dive 1.
6. After you have completed all your check out dives and met the requirements of the course you are Certified!

Be sure to ask about Advanced Adventure, Wreck, and Deep diving if they interest you!

Exclusions: Rental gear, park or quarry admission, parking fees, travel expenses, dive boat fees, tips, medical consultations (if applicable), books, education supplies, and other fees are not included unless specified. Additionally, there's a \$75 classroom fee for all eLearning classes not purchased directly through Ray Scuba. Please be aware of these additional considerations.
